ACADEMICS EHS ensures that all students make a smooth transition academically to our rigorous program. Individualized attention is provided to support students with limited or no background in Hebrew language and Jewish Studies.

COMMUNITY

- New students are warmly welcomed into their grade level and benefit from the *Social Thinking* curriculum which is taught across grades. This program fosters students' social emotional development and sense of belonging and community.
- All families receive check-in calls from our administrative team in the first semester of every school year, and new families hear directly from the Head of School. This provides opportunities for every family to provide feedback, ask questions, and discuss any concerns. Lines of communication remain open and available to EHS families at all times.



BUDDY FAMILY Each new EHS family is paired with a current EHS buddy family, chosen with careful consideration of students' ages and interests. Buddy families help encourage connections and provide familiar faces to students and parents in a new environment.

AUGUST ORIENTATION New students are part of our summer orientation program, where they meet other students joining EHS, get an insider's tour of our school, meet current students and faculty, and have time to get acclimated and ask questions before school begins.
